An estimated **4.6** million people across the UK are living with diabetes

in the UK, the **Diabetes-Related** cost per person with diabetes is **5,000 usd per year**

Globally, an estimated **422** million adults were living with diabetes in **2014**, compared to **108** million in **1980**

Diabetes, a global health crisis is expected to affect **1** in **10** people globally by **2040**, equalling **642** million with an estimated **1** in **2** adults across the world undiagnosed with Type-2 Diabetes.
